CAMP WILDERNESS “God Will Provide”



“God Will Provide Everything I Need!”



“And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.” – Philippians 4:19 (NIV)

Say:

It's easy to feel worried sometimes—especially when you hear adults talking about money or how expensive things are. Kids might wonder: “Will we have enough? Will God really take care of me?”

That's why it's important to remember a powerful truth: God is our Provider. He knows exactly what we need before we even ask!

Read:

Exodus 16

Discuss:

- What were the Israelites complaining about?
- What did God send every morning for them to eat?
- What happened to the manna if the people tried to save it for later?
- What did God provide for them at night?

Say:

The Israelites were wandering in the desert with no food, but God didn't leave them hungry. He sent food in the morning and in the evening—every day! God provided just enough for them to be full and strong.

God still takes care of His children today. He may not drop food from the sky, but He uses parents, jobs, helpers, and even miracles to provide. God is not far away or stingy—He loves to give good things to His children!

Pray:

Pray for your children's needs and any needs of others in your family. Pray for God to provide in a miraculous way. Pray for your children to trust God every day to provide and take care of them.

Activity:

As a family, make a list of five things God has provided recently—big or small. Hang it on the fridge or somewhere you'll see it each day this week. Add to it as you see God continue to provide!

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
