– 1 Corinthians 3:9

Say:

Have you ever tried to play a game all by yourself that's supposed to be for a team? It might feel silly trying to play soccer with no teammates or board games with no other players. Some things just aren't meant to be done alone!

That's how it is in God's family, too. He never meant for us to follow Him all by ourselves. He gave us teammates - our family, our friends, and our church. When we work together, something amazing happens - we win the victory!

Read:

Exodus 17:8-13

Discuss:

- Who was fighting the battle in the valley?
- What did Moses do while the battle was happening?
- What happened when Moses got tired?
- How did Aaron and Hur help Moses?

Say:

Joshua, Moses, Aaron, Hur, and the rest of the army worked together to win the victory. Not one person, but a team - all doing their part for God's plan. Joshua needed Moses, Moses needed Aaron and Hur, and we need each other, too.

Sometimes you'll be the one doing the heavy lifting, and sometimes you'll be the one holding up someone else's arms. Both are important. That's how God designed His family!

Pray:

Thank God for the teammates He's placed in your life. Ask God to help you be someone who supports and encourages others. Pray for any friends or family members who need help or encouragement right now.
