### READ:

Psalm 139:1-5, 17-18

### ASK/DISCUSS:

- How much do you really feel like you matter to God?
- Do you think these verses are for everyone, or do they just apply to certain people? Why do you think that?
- Have you ever thought you matter more to God than someone else does? For example, do you matter more than someone who has sinned a lot? Do you matter more than someone who isn't as smart, pretty, or talented as you are?
- How hard or easy is it for you to look at someone you don't like very much and still believe they matter just as much to God as you do?

### PRAY:
