Say:

Have you ever had to wait for something you really wanted—like your birthday, a special trip, or even just your snack? Waiting can be so hard! We want things right now, but sometimes—especially with God’s plans—we have to wait.

Even when we don’t understand why, we can trust that God knows exactly the right time for everything. Today we’re going to read about a man named Moses, who had to learn that waiting on God’s timing is really important.

Read:

Exodus 2:11-15

Discuss:

- What did Moses see that made him angry?
- What did Moses do to the soldier?
- Did Pharaoh find out what Moses did?
- Where did Moses run?

Say:

God had a special job for Moses, but Moses got impatient. Instead of waiting for God’s timing, he tried to fix things his own way—and that caused big problems. We do that sometimes too! We don’t want to wait, so we rush ahead and then usually things don’t work out like we hoped.
